<p>5. Class Guidelines, Rules, and Tips:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. A complete registration form, proof of vaccinations, and payment are due before the class start date. ii. All classes meet once a week for an hour for six weeks. iii. Prong collars, choke collars, shock collars, and other forceful methods are not allowed in class. iv. All dogs must come to class on a regular buckle collar and 4-6 ft leash. Body harnesses and head collars are also acceptable. Please do not bring your dog in on a retractable leash. v. Please exercise your dog for 15 minutes prior to attending class. This will give your dog a chance to let off some excess energy as well as go the bathroom if necessary. vi. Please bring plenty of small cut up treats (hot dogs and string cheese usually work well). vii. Dogs are not allowed to greet unless specified by the instructor. viii. Please refrain from using your cellphone during class. If you need to make a call, please step outside. ix. Please arrive on time so that we can start on time. x.
